In a luminous judgment, Justice Mahadevan ordered the Tamil Nadu government to make the study of Thirukkural compulsory in schools and treat it as a special subject for classes 6 to 12. He motivated his judgments by saying that students, teachers and the population as a whole bound to become responsible citizens if they learn how to apply the precepts of the saint poet in their daily life. Hypotheses of The Study Morality of High School Students are influenced by the Thirukkural. Morality of students of both genders of High School does not have much significant difference by the influence of Thirukkural. Morality of students from both the Tamil and English mediums do not have much significant difference by the influence of Thirukkural. Methodology the Survey study method is used for collecting information from your relatively large number of cases at a particular period of time. Statistical analysis was done and appropriate conclusions were derived.
