



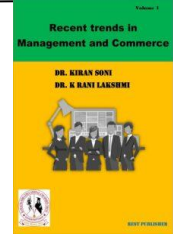

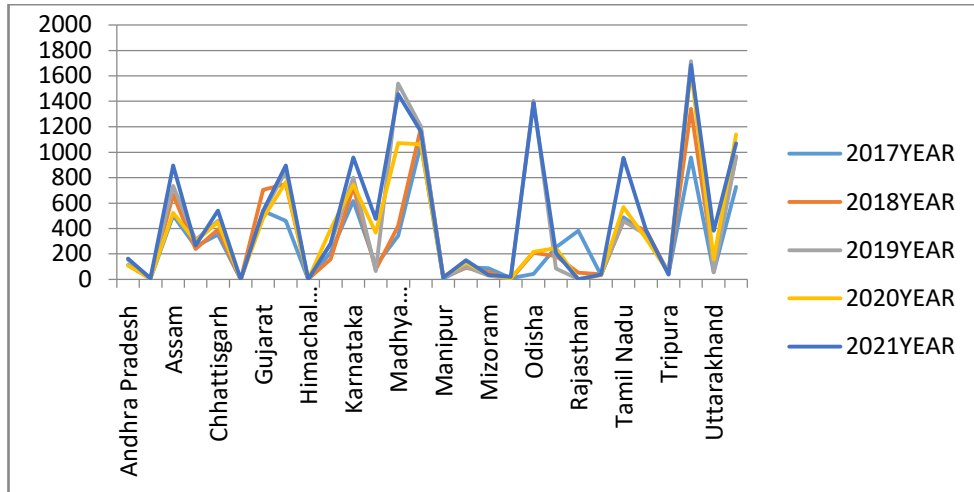


FIGURE 1. States Name
